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Section I: PREAMBLE

Large generative models are being widely adopted and used, and have the potential to transform the way individuals conceive and benefit from AI or ML technologies.

Exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement will be a court of competent jurisdiction in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China, and Tencent and Licensee consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of such court with respect to any such dispute.
